

Intensive Summary: A half-day research forum hosted by the FCNI's Research Committee will be held once again as a pre-conference session at the 2020 Westberg Symposium in Santa Fe, New Mexico. TOUR DETAILS



The Poeh Center and Museum

Located in Pojoaque, New Mexico, this Native American museum is devoted to the arts and culture of the Puebloan peoples, especially the Tewas in the northern part of the state. Guests will enjoy a guided tour of Poeh Museum. The tour consists of regional cultural orientation, current museum exhibits and tour of permanent Nah Poeh Meng Pueblo History exhibit.



Our Lady of Guadalupe Abbey

Guests will receive a brief history of monastic life from Abbot Aidan - Western under St Benedict (5th century) and Eastern under St Anthony (3rd century). As well as an overview of the Benedictine Congregation; its foundation under St Bernard Tolomei (1272-1348) and where they find ourselves today. Guests will learn about the monastic life in general and the monastic ideal, and also what it takes, through personal discernment, to become a monk. Abbot Aidan's (monk) will talk about his own discernment process. He will discuss his years living in Iran as a child, and the influence of the desert.



Loretto Chapel

This beautiful chapel is known for its unusual helix-shaped spiral staircase. The Sisters of Loretto credit St. Joseph with its construction. Once in the Chapel, you will hear an audio recording giving the history of the Chapel and this miraculous staircase. In addition, guests will receive a Santa Fe Tour guided by The Loretto Line which has been conducting tours of historic Santa Fe since 1992. Their guides are seasoned veterans and some of the best in the USA. The city tour will cover an 8-10 mile loop, which includes the most important historical areas and highlights of Santa Fe, such as Canyon Road, the historic neighborhoods, and Museum Hill. The tour lasts approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.
